**On 9/18/07 at 1AM, in front of the 700 block of Pacific Ave.,** a woman approached the front gate of the apartment complex and was confronted by two men, one of whom produced a gun and held it to her waist. The armed man ordered her to, "break yourself." This suspect then removed a \$20.00 bill from the victim's pants pocket. The two suspects then fled onto Stockton St.

**On 9/18/07 at 10:26 AM, near the intersection of Post & Kearny, Officer Rob Cebalo** saw a man yelling profanities and pounding his fists onto the hood and against the windows of a car. As the car inched forward in an attempt to escape the tirade, the irate individual continued to punch the hood of the car with his fists. Officer Cebalo approached the man to determine the situation. The individual then turned his aggression toward Officer Cebalo. Although Officer Cebalo was in full uniform, the man began yelling, "Police, Police! Someone call the Police." Officer Cebalo attempted to detain the individual, and a physical struggle ensued. Officer Cebalo wrestled the man to the ground. As the struggle continued, Officer Cebalo felt the subject attempting to remove the firearm from his holster. Officer Cebalo was able to gain control of the struggle and with the assistance of a passing citizen, handcuffed the mad individual. After the arrest, it was determined that the individual is on active probation from Contra Costa County and that his previous arrests include threatening/resisting a Peace Officer and being under the influence of a controlled substance.

**On 9/18/07 between 6:05 PM and midnight, on the 900 block of California,** a subject entered a hotel room and stole several items, including an engagement ring valued at \$45,000.00. No suspect description.

**On 9/18/07 at 11 PM, in the area of Post & Jones, Officer Scott Korte** was on foot patrol when he observed two individuals attempting to hide in a doorway. Upon approaching them, one began running from the scene. **Officers Jason Gallagher and Kevin Worrell** were nearby and assisted Officer Korte in arresting the subject who had fled. A warrant check revealed that the individual was a registered sex offender with an outstanding warrant for a violation of parole.

**On 9/19/07 at 11:50 AM, on the 200 block of Sutter,** a subject entered the retail establishment and concealed 3 shirts inside a plastic bag. An employee confronted the subject and was assaulted when he retrieved the store's property. The suspect was described as a white male, 25-30 years old, 6'0", 180 Lbs. with a mullet hairstyle.

**On 9/20/07 between 1130 AM and 1:30 PM, on the 100 block of Maiden Lane,** two separate fires occurred inside the commercial establishment. SFPD and SFFD are both investigating the incident as arson. Possible suspect description is a Hispanic male 26-28 years old, 5'9", 200 Lbs.

**On 9/20/07 between 2:30 PM and 3:20 PM, on the 1500 block of Washington St.,** a subject forced entry into an occupied apartment. The suspect stole a laptop computer and a backpack while the occupant was asleep.
