Shooting into inhabited dwelling 95 Kiska Road 4:50 am

The victim can to Bayview Station an said that she and a co-worker were in her vehicle driving south on Dormitory when she say two black males standing in front of 195 Kiska Road. One of the black males was standing behind a tree next to 195 Kiska and one black male was standing in the doorway of 195 Kiska. The suspect near the tree began shooting at the victim. There was one bullet hole in the driver's door. The victim and the passenger were not injured. No suspects were identified.
