Crime and Enforcement Update

Burglary, residence DV related 051305 unit blk Harbor

They had a dating relationship and the residence let this person stay in their house on occasion. The suspect then assaulted the victim. He then started smoking crack and refused to let the victim leave. The responding officers shared the suspect information with other units. A short time later a unit spotted the suspect and he was arrested.

Possession of Cocaine 051305 3rd St and Yosemite
