Crime and Enforcement Update

Buy-Bust Operation

Bayview plainclothes officers, working with members of our Narcotics Unit, conducted a buy-bust operation in the district yesterday, resulting in numerous arrests. The following cases were made:

At 12:55 p.m., a Narcotics officer purchased crack cocaine from a man at Middlepoint and Hare. The seller, living on Wills, was booked for sales of crack cocaine (050 210 447).

At 1:16 p.m., a Narcotics officer purchased crack cocaine from a man on the 1500 block of Palou. The seller was booked for sales of crack cocaine, possession of narcotics paraphernalia, and destroying evidence (050 210 544).

At 1:24 p.m., a Narcotics officer purchased crack cocaine from a man at 3rd and Newcomb. The seller, living on Cashmere, was booked for sales and possession for sale of crack cocaine. The seller was also charged with possession of heroin. A man with the seller was arrested for possession of marijuana for sale (050 210 704).

At 2:07 p.m., a Narcotics officer purchased crack cocaine from a man at Fitzgerald and Jennings. The seller, living on the 100 block of Addison, was arrested for sales of crack cocaine (050 210 867).

At 3:35 p.m., a Narcotics officer purchased crack cocaine from two men on the 900 block of Connecticut. The first man was booked for sales of crack cocaine. The second man was booked for both sales and violation of probation (050 211 423).

At 4:55 p.m., a Narcotics officer purchased crack cocaine from a man at 3rd and Newcomb. The seller, living on Webster Street, was booked for sales of crack cocaine and violation of probation (050 211 752).

Warrant Arrest, February 23, 10:24 a.m.  
Officer Lavin responded to the 100 block of Carolina on a complaint of homeless people living in their vehicles. The officer found two trailers parked at the scene with the wrong plates. Both trailers were towed. While one of the trailers was being towed, a man exited and was found to have an outstanding arrest warrant. The man, homeless, was booked for two warrants (050 209 456).

Aggravated Assault, Domestic Violence, February 23, 10:47 a.m.  
Officers Kwan and Hui responded to Silver and Topeka on the report of a fight and located a couple, each with visible injuries. The officers interviewed both parties and determined that the female was angry with the male regarding money owed to her, and as a result of her anger had stabbed the man seven times with a screwdriver. The female had a laceration to her forehead which was apparently received when she head-butted the man. The woman, living on Robblee, was booked for aggravated assault and domestic violence (050509 882).

Warrant Arrest, Possession Ecstasy, February 23, 2:00 p.m.  
Officers Lyons and Scott, along with Sgt. Fabbri, were on patrol at 2401 Keith when they saw a man they knew to be wanted. The man was arrested and a quantity of ecstasy was found in his pocket. The man, living on the 900 block of Key, was booked for the warrant and the ecstasy (050 211 229).

Possession of Cocaine for Sale, February 23, 4:40 p.m.  
Officers DeJesus, Izaguirre and Solares were on patrol when they received a

phone call on our Narcotics tip phone (listed below) regarding a man selling drugs on the 1300 block of Quesada. The caller provided officers with a detailed description of the dealer, including the fact that he was accompanied by a pit bull dog. The caller also stated that he had seen the drug dealer conduct numerous transactions. The officers located the described man and found 7 rocks of crack cocaine in his waistband. The suspect, living on the 1600 block of Jennings, was booked for possession of crack cocaine for sale (050 211 699).

Stolen Auto, Restraining Order Violation, February 23, 7:15 p.m. Officer Olson was following up on a report he had taken from a woman who had told him that her ex-boyfriend, against whom she had a stay-away order, had just stolen her car. The officer responded to the boyfriend's home and located both the auto and the boyfriend. The boyfriend, living on the 1200 block of Fitzgerald, was booked for stolen auto and violation of a court order (050 212 120).

Attempted Homicide with Knife, February 23, 7:48 p.m. Officer Archini responded to the first block of Northridge on a report of a stabbing incident. The officer found a man with stab wounds who was being treated by ambulance personnel. The victim was taken to SFGH and the officers at the scene attempted to interview numerous neighbors who were present, none of whom would provide any information. The officers then learned from a man that his stepdaughter had just stabbed her boyfriend following an argument. The suspect, covered with blood, was found in the area and was arrested. The officers interviewed the victim at SFGH, but he told them that an unknown woman had entered his apartment and stabbed him for no reason. The victim had seven stab wounds and was admitted to the hospital. The suspect, living on the 1200 block of Oakdale, was booked for attempted murder, aggravated assault, and domestic violence (050 212 556).
