Crime and Enforcement Update

MURDER WANT

A murder warrant has been issued for the arrest of Larry Carr, who has been charged in the slaying of Richard Banks. The murder took place September 30, 2004, following an attempted robbery in front of 106 6th Street. Carr is known to frequent the Doublerock Housing development in the Bayview. Carr was born in 1978, and is 5'8", 220 pounds. Photos are available at Bayview Station and can be faxed to persons who believe they know or have seen Carr (041 119 191).

On December 5, at 11:00 p.m., (not reported until 12/6 at 11:30 p.m. due to victim being scared) a man went to 1410 Innes to deliver take-out Chinese food and was approached by two men, both of whom were armed with small black handguns. The suspects demanded money from the victim, and when he told them he had none, they decided to take the food. The suspects then went to the victim's vehicle and stole his CD player. As the victim was driving away from the area, the suspects fired three rounds at his car, hitting it once. Suspect one is a black male, 20-25, 5'8", 150, wearing a black beanie and blue jean pants. Suspect two is a black male, 5'8", 150, wearing a black beanie and blue jean pants (041 387 990).

On December 6, at 5:14 a.m., Bayview officers responded to 3rd and Revere on an assault call. The victim told officers that he was riding the 15 line Muni on 3rd Street at Fitzgerald when two men got onto the bus and walked to the rear of the bus and approached him. The suspects began to go through the victim's pockets and the victim pushed the suspects away from him. The suspects then began to punch the victim numerous times, prior to fleeing from the bus at 3rd and Revere. Suspect one is a black male, early 20's, 20-30, 5'11", 230, 5" Afro haircut, wearing a blue jacket and baggy jeans. Suspect two is a Hispanic male, 20-30, 6'0", 210, wearing a white baseball cap, white sweatshirt, and red "puffy" jacket (041 383 813).

On December 6, at 11:00 a.m., Bayview officers responded to the 1500 block of Bayshore on an assault in progress call. The reportee told officers

that he was working at the U-Haul on Bayshore when he saw a black Chevy Tahoe enter the lot followed by a silver Lexus. The reportee then saw five males exit the Lexus, which had parked behind the Tahoe. One of the occupants of the Lexus then approached the driver of the Tahoe and began to argue with him, eventually pulling him out of the vehicle and throwing him to the ground. The suspect then proceeded to kick and beat the victim, prior to entering the victim's Tahoe and driving away, followed by the four males driving the Lexus. The victim required hospitalization for his injuries and the officers accompanied him to the hospital for an interview, but he was very reluctant to cooperate. The victim eventually told officers that the man who had beat him was the brother of his "...baby's mama." The victim could provide no explanation for the beating, other than to say that all of the suspects were "Jehovah's witnesses, who do things their own way." The officers attempted to follow the case up by responding to the address of the registered owner of the Tahoe. The registered owner's mother told officers that the victim in the case had stolen the Tahoe from her daughter (mother of victim's child) earlier in the day. The daughter's family apparently then decided to recover the vehicle without benefit of police assistance (041 385 621).

On December 6, at 11:30 a.m., Bayview officers responded to Marshall High School at 45 Conkling on a drug possession call. A teacher at the school told officers that he had caught one of his students with a baggie of marijuana and had called police. The student, living on Andover, was cited for possession of marijuana on school grounds (041 385 994).

On December 6, at 12:56 p.m., Bayview officers were on patrol at 25th and Connecticut when they saw a man they knew to be wanted and arrested him. The man, living on Middlepoint Road, was booked for an outstanding arrest warrant charging him with sales of cocaine (020 473 017).

On December 6, at 4:33 p.m., Bayview officers responded to 25th and Connecticut on a domestic violence report. The female caller told officers that she had been dating a man for a month and had allowed him to move into her home because he was homeless. When the relationship soured, the woman asked the man to leave and he refused. In a fit of anger, the man pushed the woman to the ground and choked her. He then slammed her head on the ground numerous times and fled. The suspect is Jerime Lewis, 52 years old, 5'11", 220 (041 386 867).

On December 6, at 6:03 p.m., Bayview officers responded to a home on the 1600 block of McKinnon on a domestic violence call. An intoxicated man met the officers at the front gate and stated that he had just been hit over the head with a cooking pot. The female caller told officers that the male was her husband, but they have been separated for five years, during which time the husband has attended domestic violence classes. The victim told officers that her husband was involved in an argument with her other family members earlier in the day and had left the home following the argument. When the husband returned he was quite drunk and tried to force open the front gate of the home. The wife opened the gate and the husband began to grab and shake her. The husband, living on Bridgeview Circle, was booked for domestic violence (041 387 285).

On December 6, at 6:35 p.m., Bayview officers responded to a home on the

1100 block of Connecticut on a domestic violence call. The female caller told officers that she broke up with her boyfriend yesterday, and when he came to her home today they became involved in an argument, followed by the boyfriend pulling her hair and pushing her. An emergency protective order was issued. The suspect is Milton Wright, 25 years old, 5'10", 141, living on Palou (041 387 354).

On December 6, at 8:15 p.m., Bayview officers responded to a home on the 2100 block of 18th Street on a domestic violence call. The female caller told officers that her boyfriend had just beat her following an argument. The boyfriend, who is from France, had invited several of his friends to stay in the apartment, and when the girlfriend told him that the friends had overstayed their welcome and should stay in a hotel, the boyfriend became enraged and struck the girlfriend numerous times. An emergency protective order was issued. The suspect is Mattieu Lieber, 31 years of age, 6'0", 190 (041 387 586).

On December 6, at 9:10 p.m., a woman reported to Bayview officers that she was riding a Muni bus near Gilman when a man stole her purse from her and ran from the bus when it stopped. The suspect is described as a black male, 30-40, 5'11", 230, short dreadlock hair, goatee, wearing a black leather jacket, blue shirt and black pants (041 387 746).
