Crime and Enforcement Update

On 12/17/2004 at approximately 8pm officers Solares, Fabbri, Dejesus and Fitzpatrick saw a honda occupied by 2 black males in the area of Beatrice and Espanola Streets. The Honda drove off after jumping the curb in an effort to evade the Officers. After a few turns the vehicle came to a stop and the officer witnessed the passenger place something under the front passenger seat. After securing both individuals for their safety a search revealed a .25 cal pistol under the passenger seat. the officers also found cocaine and ecstasy pills. Another item recovered from the honda was a ski mask. One suspected was arrested for possession of a firearm in a vehicle as well as some narctotics offenses. The driver of the vehicle was arrested for driving w/o a license and outstanding warrants. (041430862)

On 12/17/04 at 10pm Officers responded to 700 block of Delta St in the Ingleside District in response to a person breaking into a residence. When they arrived the doors were locked and they were unable to get in. Dispatch told them the victim had locked herself in a bedroom and would not come out because she heard someone moving things in her kitchen. Officers tried to talk the suspect into opening the door but were unsuccessful. They forced open the door and found the suspect in the kitchen, It was determined that the suspect was the son of the victim, however there was a restraining order preventing the son from being near the residence. the son was arrested and charge with violating a restraining order and delaying an ivestigation. On 12/17/04 at 1:45PM Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Mendell on a report of Domestic Violence. Officers arrested an individual for domestic violence. the victime stated that the suspect had used drugs the night before and possibly was coming down from them when he attacked her. (041429326)

On 12/17/04 at 2:40pm plain clothes officers from Bayview Station were in the area of the 1000 block of Connecticut when they observed an individual they knew. this individual had a stay away order for that area. the suspect

On 12/17/04 at 3:15am Officer responded to the 400 block of Connecticut on a report of a car being burglarized. When officer arrived they were directed to an individual who was trying to walk away south on Connecticut. the witness identified the suspect as the one who was breaking into vehicles. As the officer attempted to stop the suspect, he dropped the items he was carrying and ran. the officers pursued the suspect and arrested him after a brief foot chase. The investigation continued and the officers were able to contact the owner of the vehicle. He identified the items dropped by the suspect as belonging to him and stated they were in his vehicle. Suspect booked for auto burglary. (041427364)

On 12/17/04 at 10:20 am on the 1000 block of silver a woman was robbed. While two women were waiting at the bus stop a BM 34 to 37 yrs old approached and grabbed a purse, pushing the victim to the ground. the second victim refused to give up her purse and the suspect punched her in the face eventually making off with both purses.
