Crime and Enforcement Update

Carjacking and Robbery with Gun Felton & San Bruno

Two victims were seated in their parked car when they were approached by two suspects who demanded money. As the victims hesitated, one suspect produced a handgun placing it directly into the drivers stomach. The driver then gave his wallet and contents before both victims exited the vehicle and began running away. Both suspects entered the vehicle and drove off.
