Crime and Enforcement Update

Aggravated Assault with Gun 0500 hrs.

1400 block Quint St.

Victim was backing his vehicle out of his garage when he was approached by a suspect on foot. The suspect then produced a handgun, pointing and firing one shot at the victim. The bullet missed, striking the drivers side door. The suspect then ran to a waiting white truck which left the scene. The victim was not injured in the attack. The victim believes the incident may be related to a prior relationship.

Attempted Robbery with Force

Third & Williams

1730 hrs.

Victim got off a bus when he was confronted by two suspects who grabbed the victims cell phone from his hands. The suspect with the phone ran into Walgreens Store pursued by the victim. As the victim caught up with him, the suspect punched the victim in the face. The suspect then threw the cell phone to the other suspect and both fled a short dstance before the victim again caught up with both suspects. The suspects hid the phone in the area prior to leaving on foot. The victim was able to retrieve his cell phone which was hidden in a nearby portable toilet. The victim believes he has seen the suspects on the bus on a prior occasion.

During a soccer match several players engaged in a physical scuffle with referees over a perceived bad call. Two players attacked one referee delivering kicks and punches to the referee's leg and face. Several spectators attempted to break up the fight. The referee sustained a broken nose. Both suspects then ran to a cream colored Honda which was occupied by two other males, who then drove away from the scene.
