#### Crime and Enforcement Update

Possession Ammunition by Minor, 45 Conkling, April 4, 2:27 p.m. Bayview Officer Miller was working at Marshall High School when the vice principal reported to him that a male student had been detained following a threats incident. The student had become involved in an argument with another student during a basketball game (regarding which team had possession of the ball), and the first student stated that he was going to "clap" (shoot) the second student. The first student was searched and several rounds of live ammunition were found in his backpack, but no gun was located. The student, 16 years of age and living on Underwood, was booked for threats and possession of ammunition by a minor on school grounds (050 370 289).

Shots into a Vehicle, 1730 Newcomb, April 5, 8:07 a.m. Bayview Officers Reyes and Pai took a report from a man who told them that he had found two bullet holes in the rear windows of his parked vehicle. The victim heard no shots and had no information about suspects or motive (050 373 001).

Domestic Violence, 1000 block of Griffith, April 5, 9:20 a.m. Bayview Officers Lew and Berge responded a call of a domestic violence incident in progress and spoke with the female caller who stated that she had been in an argument with her boyfriend regarding her cell phone. The boyfriend became enraged and punched the victim several times in her face prior to choking her and biting her finger. The boyfriend fled prior to the arrival of the officers. The case is being investigated by our Domestic Violence Unit (050 373 324).

Aggravated Assault, Fitzgerald and Hawes, April 5, 12:23 p.m. Bayview Officers Doherty and Lamma responded on a report of an assault and met with the female caller who told them that another female (an acquaintance from the area) had approached her and began to punch and

strike her. The female suspect choked and bit the victim, and also threatened to kill her. The suspect was located by officers and was booked for aggravated assault and making terrorist threats. The victim was treated at the hospital for numerous physical injuries (050 373 932).

Found Gun on School Premises, 45 Conkling, April 5, 1:59 p.m.  
Bayview Officer Nasir was called to the office of the dean of students at Marshall High School and was given a bag containing a revolver. The dean would not tell the officer where the gun had been found or who had turned it in. The gun was reported stolen from Pasadena, California in 1993. It is unknown if the gun is related to the above described incident involving the ammunition, although, if they are not related, it appears to be a rather implausible coincidence (050 374 645).

Burglary, 1334 Donner, April 5, 8:50 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Escobar and Calaunan responded on the report of a group of juveniles who had just stolen a fork-lift. The officers found a fork-lift parked near the Alice Griffith Housing Development, and as they approached the fork-lift, they saw three male juveniles running away from it toward the development. The fork-lift was returned to the business from which it had been stolen. The suspects are described only as black male juveniles (050 376 027).

Warrant Arrest, 900 block of Ingerson, April 5, 9:01 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Whitfield and Norris responded on a report that a person was attempting to commit suicide. The female caller told officers that her boyfriend was threatening suicide because she wanted to end their relationship. The boyfriend, 17 years of age and wanted for an outstanding criminal warrant, was taken to the Youth Guidance Center where the staff was apprised of his statements about suicide and saw to it that the young man received psychiatric assistance (050 376 168).

Warrant Arrest, 900 Quint, April 5, 9:57 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Erb and Johnson were on patrol when they saw two men together, one of whom was urinating on the street. The officers detained both men and cited the urinator (I'm not sure that's a real word) for his offense. The second man was booked for an outstanding arrest warrant. Both men live on the 200 block of Blythdale (050 376 259).

Illegal Lodging, 19th and Illinois, April 5, 10:10 p.m.  
Bayview Officer Buelow was on patrol when he found two persons watching television inside a motorhome parked on a public street. The officer has cited the individuals on numerous prior occasions for illegal lodging on public streets, and they were again cited (050 376 334).

Obstructing a Peace Officer, McKinnon and Lane, April 5, 10:23 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Chiang and Borgen were on patrol when they stopped a vehicle for traffic violations and were told by the driver that he didn't have his license with him. As the officers were attempting to verify the name provided to them by the driver, he suddenly took off running and was lost in the area. The vehicle was towed with a hold for our Auto Detail (050 376 356).

Warrant Arrest, Napoleon and Evans, April 5, 11:26 p.m.  
Bayview Officer Buelow was on patrol when he found a woman that he knew to be wanted living in a large homeless encampment. The woman was booked for several warrants charging her with a variety of drug and other offenses (050 256 805).

Robbery, 1653 McKinnon, April 5, 11:30 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Bradford and Gallo responded on an assault call involving a man who has been known to carry firearms. The female caller told officers that she had been involved in an argument with a male acquaintance of hers who became enraged when she received a phone call on her cell phone. The male threatened to shoot the caller and then punched her several times and stole her car keys. The officers located the male, living in Daly City, and booked him on felony charges (050 376 453).
