Metropolitan Arts and Tech High School, or "Metro" for short, is a small, college preparatory, free public charter school that is moving to 400 Mansell Street for the coming school year. The school will be sharing a campus with Philip and Sala Burton High School (formerly Woodrow Wilson High School) in the Portola/Visitacion Valley area, just a short trip from the Bayview area.

Metro has small class sizes, excellent teachers, nationally-recognized teaching methods, and a focus on arts and digital media, which is integrated into all of the subjects. All of the courses meet the requirements for admission to the University of California system. Metro is one of four Envision Schools, a Bay Area network of high-performing public charter high schools.
