SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS:

Officer Bandvik, while on patrol, found a vehicle that had been carjacked on June 28, 2008. Officer Bandvik notified the plainclothes team who watched the vehicle until three suspects returned and got into the vehicle. Officers had cause to arrest the driver of the vehicle only. The other two suspects were released. An investigation regarding the carjacking is on-going.

ARRESTS OF INTEREST:

July 8, 2008 – Firearm, Loaded in car – Possession by a Prohibited person – Gang Related – 10:46:pm – 200 blk of Westpoint :

Members of Bayview's plainclothes team were in the area of Westpoint and Middlepoint Rd when they observed an individual, who they know from prior arrests, looking in the direction of the police car, while quickly running behind the building. Officers ran after the suspect and saw him throw a gun on top of a low lying roof. Officers placed the suspect under arrest for the gun, found suspected narcotics on him as well and transported him to Bayview Station to be booked. Officer Broberg, of the Gang Task Force unit, responded to Bayview Station and confirmed that the suspect was a full fledged member of the street gang, West Mob. Additional charges will be placed on the suspect for his gang affiliation.

July 9, 2008-Air Gun Possession-11:13am-500 blk of Girard-CN#080708785:

Officer Catlett was driving in the area of Girard St, when he saw a person, lying on a citizen's stairs, sleeping. The person also had his pants around his ankles. Officer Catlett ran the person's identification and found that he had a search condition. Officer Catlett searched the individual and found a BB Gun on him. Officer Catlett cited the individual and confiscated the BB Gun.

Officers spoke with the victim who told them that he found a bullet hole in the wall of the building. Officers collected the casing. No one was hurt during the incident. No suspects were arrested.

Burglary: NO ARREST:

July 7, 2008-1:51am-800 blk of Terry Francois-CN#080707793:

Officers McNamara and Lane responded to the area of Terry Francois regarding an alarm activation. Officers gained access to the building via the owner, who arrived soon after. Officers did not find any suspects, but did find that the rear sliding glass door had been forced open and several pry marks on the frame of the door. The screen door had been removed and was leaning against the railing. One laptop was stolen from the business. No suspects were found. No one was injured during the incident.

July 10, 2008-Firearm, Loaded in Vehicle, Weapon, Carrying Concealed-2:09am-1400 blk of Revere-CN#080719635:

Officers Cabuntala and Alvarenga were working undercover in the area of Revere and Jennings. Officers heard loud music being played inside a vehicle that was slowly approaching where these officers were conducting an investigation. Officers stopped the vehicle and spoke with the occupants. Members of Bayview's Housing Team responded to a stabbing. Officers spoke with the victim and a suspect, who was also a victim. The first victim told officers that the suspect stabbed him with a long kitchen knife, due to an on-going feud. The suspect, aka victim, told Officers that the victim pointed a small, silver gun at him, so he grabbed a kitchen knife and stabbed at the victim. The suspect/victim, also stated that there had been an ongoing feud between the two parties. No small, silver gun was found. The victim was not injured, nor was the suspect/victim.
