I apologize to all for missing the Monday Newsletter, but events are keeping us pretty busy here at the station.

Yesterday, the ninth homicide of the year occurred here in the Bayview. As of this time last year, there had been only five. The shooting occurred, as you will see below, on Turner Terrace in the middle of the day. And although our officers did an extensive canvas of the area, we were provided little information on exactly what happened. It is obvious, that people in the area are either afraid to tell the police what happened or they simply don't care. I believe, based upon the many community members I have come to know, that the former is true and folks are simply too afraid to tell the police what they saw. I bring this point up because I feel it's a good time to remind everyone that there are two separate anonymous tip lines available to Bayview residents:

If you witness a crime, and don't want to become involved, please call the tip line and tell us what you saw. Oftentimes, all the officers need is a good description, a license plate, or a name to solve the case, and arrest the bad guy.

April 1, 2008-Homicide, W/Gun-Turner Terrace-1:38pm-CN#080339835:
Bayview Station officers responded to Missouri St and Turner Terrace regarding a shooting.
Officers rendered aid to a victim inside a vehicle and called for an ambulance. Officers Scott,
Lyons and Ellis of the plainclothes team responded as well and saw a vehicle leaving the area.
Officers stopped and detained the vehicle and were able to gather information regarding the suspects. Officer Mattei then notified officers on scene that the victim in the vehicle had died as a result of his gunshot wound.

Officers spoke with the victims who told them that there was an unknown female who had been harassing her and her family for the past couple of day. The victim stated that she is not the intended target and that the suspect has mistakenly identified her for another female. No arrest was made.
