Crime and Enforcement Update

Burglary with Suspect Seen, 547 Arkansas, July 19, 3:30 p.m.
Bayview Officer Kwan responded on a burglary call and spoke with a contractor building a new home. The victim reported that his storage container, stored on the street in front of the house being built, had been broken into and all of his tools were missing. A witness had seen a white male suspect, driving a red pick-up truck, back into the storage shed's door, breaking it, at approximately 4:00 a.m. the previous morning. The witness had then seen the suspect stealing all the tools (050 808 763).

Possession Stolen Computer, 50 Newhall, July 20, 4:34 a.m.
Bayview Officers Damonte and Lavin were on patrol when they saw a parked Bobtail truck with its roll-up door raised and stopped to check on it. A woman crawled out from underneath the truck and was immediately recognized as a local transient who has been arrested numerous times in the recent past. Inside the truck the officers found a large collection of electronic equipment, including two computers. One of the computers had been reported as stolen (its serial number was listed in the stolen property database), and the woman was arrested for possession of stolen property. The truck was towed and the electronic equipment was booked as evidence (050 808 600).

Cocaine Arrest, 1526 Kirkwood, July 20, 12:22 p.m.
Bayview Officers Benzinger, Ellis and Kirchner were on patrol when they saw a known gang member speaking with a man known to have a stay-away order. The man with the stay-away order, living on Osceola, was arrested and booked for violating a court order and violation of probation. The second man, a validated member of the BNT gang (Broke N-word Thievin'), was arrested for possession of crack cocaine for sale and possession of marijuana (050 809 686).

Indecent Exposure, 700 block of Earl, July 20, 1:00 p.m.
Bayview Officer Damonte responded on an indecent exposure call and spoke with the caller who reported that a man walked into her business and asked if any new employees were needed. When the caller told the man "no," the man pulled down his pants and exposed himself, stating, "Well, what about

this." The victim told the man that, even with this new development, she was not hiring. The suspect then fled (050 809 802).

Stay Away Order Violation, 3rd and Palou, July 20, 3:10 p.m.
Bayview's plainclothes officers were on patrol when they saw a group of men loitering on the corner and recognized one of the men as having a stay-away order. The man, living on the 5200 block of 3rd Street, was arrested for violation of a court order (050 810 401).

Possession Cocaine and Heroin, McKinnon and Newhall, July 20, 3:27 p.m.
Bayview's plainclothes officers were on patrol when they saw several men loitering on the corner. As the officers approached the men, one of them took off running and threw a plastic baggie to the ground. The man was detained and the plastic baggie was found to contain crack cocaine. The man was arrested and searched, and an additional stash of both crack and heroin was found hidden in his underwear. The man, living on Perry Street, was booked for possession of crack cocaine for sale and possession of heroin (050 810 439).

Robbery, 4850 3rd Street, July 20, 4:02 p.m.
Bayview Officer Dalton took a report of a robbery from a Spanish speaking man who reported that as he was leaving a check cashing store he was approached by several men who attempted to rob him, but were scared away when a witness began to phone the police. Suspect one is a Hispanic male, 25, 5'10", 160, slight goatee, wearing a red shirt and baseball hat on backwards. Suspects two to four are black males with no further description (050 810 718).

Stolen Auto, 800 Bayshore, July 20, 5:12 p.m.
Bayview Officers Erb and Calaunan were on patrol when they saw a Sheriff's Department vehicle driving at 3rd and Shafter which had been described earlier by Dispatch as a stolen vehicle. The officers attempted to stop the Sheriff's vehicle, which had its emergency lights illuminated! Apparently the thief was not averse to drawing attention to himself. The suspect stopped the stolen vehicle on Bayshore and was taken into custody after a brief struggle. The suspect, living in Oakland, was booked for stolen auto, resisting arrest, and violation of parole (050 811 045).

Warrant Arrest, Oakdale and Griffith, July 20, 7:31 p.m.
Bayview's plainclothes officers were on patrol when they saw a man they knew to be wanted and arrested him for an outstanding warrant. The man, living in Daly City, was booked for both the warrant and for trespassing on public housing property (050 584 543).
