Our bicycle officers were in the area of 1700 block of McKinnon moving some of the nuisance individuals. One of the individuals told them that this house was being broken into. One of the officers responded to the rear of the house and then the garage door opened and a suspect ran out. The

officer in front gave chase and requested assistance. Several Bayview units responded and the officer chased the suspect for several minutes. The suspect jumped the fence and now was in the backyards on the 1600 block of Kirkwood. He jumped several fences with officers behind him. The suspect was eventually arrested. Two officers were injured during the chase. One officer needed eight stitches to close a laceration to his hand. He is expected to be off work for a few weeks. The other officer fell several feet and landed on his elbow, he is expected to return to work in a couple of days. The suspect was on parole and was booked for the burglary as well as a parole violation. Officer Curtain from the burglary detail responded to Bayview station and interviewed all the parties. He will continue his investigation and then present the case to the district attorney's office.
