# VIOLENCE REDUCTION Noteworthy Accomplishment

The San Francisco Police Department received the Outstanding Local Police Department Involvement Award for its innovative violence reduction strategy designed to direct a concerted enforcement effort in "hot spots" in each of the 10 police districts in the city. The department reduced homicides by 54 percent and shootings by 34 percent this past year.
