Officers Santiago and Ortiz responded to a call regarding a stabbing. Officer met with the victim, who had a cut on his forehead. Officers called for a medic to respond and treat the victim. The victim stated that he had a physical altercation with a tenant and that the tenant stabbed him. The officers located the suspect, but after interviewing her, it was determined that there was no merit to a stabbing. Officers released the suspect and discovered a warrant for the victim, who was taken into custody.

Officer Ng responded to a store regarding a shoplifter. Officer Ng met with store security who had one suspect detained. The victim and a witness said that the suspect fled down the street and dropped the gun along the way. Officers searched for the suspect and the gun, to no avail.

Officer Ng responded to a call regarding a possible assault. Officer Ng spoke with a victim, who stated that he was robbed on his way home, by five suspects. May 21, 2009-Assault with Caustic Chemicals-6:00pm-1500 blk of Silver-CN#090528567:

Members of Bayview's housing team were in the area of Silver and San Bruno when they were flagged down regarding a person who had been sprayed in the face with pepper spray. The victim told officers that she had been involved in a physical altercation with another female. The fight ended and the victim stated she looked into a car mirror to check her hair. As she did this, the suspect came up behind her and sprayed her in the face. The suspect then fled the area on foot. A medic arrived and further treated the victim. Officers were unable to get any substantial information from the victim, who stated she would take up the matter with the suspect's mother.
