One of the suspects engaged in small talk with the victim. The same suspect then grabbed at the purse hanging from the woman's shoulder. Research showed that this person was on probation and subject to a warrantless search at anytime. The officers moved in to search the building when they were spotted. One of the occupants smashed a rear window, and tossed out a sizable amount of crack cocaine. Four people then left through a rear door, gained access to a fire escape and went into the downstairs apartment.

Entry was made into the unit that the suspects ran into. The suspects were found in the living room and three teenage girls were in the kitchen crying. They told the police that they do not know the boys that ran inside and that they were afraid.

The officers searched the original apartment that the suspects escaped. Crack, heroin, and marijuana all packaged for sale were found in various locations. Under a mattress was a loaded AK47 and a handgun. The serial number on the

handgun indicated that it was stolen from Monterey County and may have been used in a homicide.

The four suspects were booked for various weapons violations, narcotics violations, false imprisonment of the teenagers. The suspects all have gang affiliations and they were also charged with a gang enhancement.
