baggie deeper into his pants to conceal it. He continued to struggle with Officer Singh who called for backup. After the scene was brought under control it was discovered that the suspect was attempting to hide a large amount of crack cocaine in his pants. He was booked for numerous narcotics related charges and resisting arrest.
