### ARRESTS:

#### **September 13, 2009-Attempted Robbery w/gun, Warrant, Parole Violation-4:21am-1197 Hollister-CN#090942553:**

Officers Talusan and Rodriguez were in the area of Hollister Street when a civilian approached their police cruiser and told the officers that he had just been robbed. The officers ran over to the area where the victim had been and saw a suspect crouched underneath a set of stairs. As they approached the suspect, the officers heard the sound of a metal object being dropped into the mailbox. Officers detained the suspect and looked inside the mailbox, locating a firearm. Officers placed the suspect into custody and the victim positively identified the suspect as the one who robbed him.
